1. Jessica has \$100. She spends \$40 on a dress, then wants to buy as much chocolate as she can with \$4 per bar. How many chocolate bars can she buy?

2. John has \$120 and wants to cut up this amount into 4 equal parts. After giving three parts away, how much money is left?

3. A charity has \$200 and wants to create 5 donation boxes, where each group has the same amount. If they spend \$50 on supplies, how much money will each group have?

4. Sarah and her 7 friends found \$160. They decide on equal sharing but also want to donate twice their individual share to charity. How much will they donate in total?

5. Tom earns \$300 from his job and \$200 from his hobby. If he wants to save half of his total earnings, how much will he save?

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Division Word Problems

1. Mary has \$180 and wants to divide it into sixths. She spends two of these parts on clothing. How much did she spend?

2. There are \$140 in a savings account and \$60 in a checking account. If this money is divided equally into 5 investments, how much will be in each investment?

3. A company has \$210 and wants to divide it into 3 parts for different departments. If one department spends triple its part, how much will it spend?

4. A shop sells 6 toys for \$24 each and 4 toys for \$18 each. If they want to sell all of the toys for the same price per unit, how much will each toy cost?

5. If 9 friends have a total of \$450, and they decide to share something equally but then spend \$50 for a gift, how much will each friend have left?
